

In our Pre-k lessons we aim to introduce the English language in a fun-filled, creative and safe environment. The Little Friends and Hippo books are used for approximately 30% of the lesson, in order to cultivate and progress their fine motor skills, teach new vocabulary and introduce letters and numbers.

By weaving spontaneous and consistent phrases and dialogues throughout the lesson, we achieve the highest possible level of comprehension in a natural manner. Our main activities (which change every 10 to 15 minutes) consist of educational games, realia games, songs, chants, crafts, simple stories and audiovisual games. Our goal is to produce more naturally motivated and young learners of the English language.
