Thodoris Filaretos, Vice President for Secondary Education



Thodoris Filaretos first came to Anatolia to teach Greek and History in 1987 and has held various positions of responsibility at Anatolia since. In 1996 he became Deputy Dean and in 1997 Dean of the First Junior High School (A' Gymnasio), a position that he gave up in 2000 to become Director of the IB Program, which had been established at Anatolia in 1998. At the IB program he also taught Theory of Knowledge.

Filaretos holds a BA in Philosophy from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and an MA in Philosophy from University College London. While teaching History at Anatolia he became especially interested in the ideological and political assumptions of historiography and history teaching, which led him in 1996 to spend a year in London at the Institute of Education as an Associate in the History in Education. He also served as editor and translator for a series on Historiography and the Teaching of History.

He assumed the position of Vice President for Secondary Education in September 2011, where he is responsible for oversight of Anatolia's two junior and senior high schools (gymnasia and lykeia) and IB Program.
